MT-USAW PETITION FORM

The head coach must approve and sign all petitions or they will be VOID. There will be no exceptions to this requirement.

1. Weather and Road Conditions:

If weather conditions prevent a wrestler from attending a qualifying tournament, the head coach must notify the tournament officials before the wrestling begins.

2. Serious or grievous family situation:

Death in the family or serious accident (verified by documentation.)

3. Participation in mandatory school or church sanctioned activity:

Verification of such activity must be documented and signed by the school principal or clergy person. This must be a required event (i.e. church confirmation or event where attendance is mandatory. NO carnivals, dances, bazaars, etc., will be considered.) All completed petitions must be received by tournament officials before the tournament starts.

4. Participation in a multi-state regional or national wrestling tournament or other nationally sanctioned wrestling event:

All completed petitions must be received by tournament officials before wrestling begins at the qualifying tournament.

5. Illness or injury:

A wrestler must have documentation from a medical professional stating the date and time of illness or injury. NO VERIFICATION, NO WRESTLING. Petitioners must see a medical professional to diagnose illness or injury, and must obtain a written release before he/she can resume wrestling.
