

Cost of Fargo Attendance

The approximate cost of Fargo is based upon the number of individuals who compete:

Cost of the Fargo Trip: \$800.00

This number will vary depending on donations/fundraising projects that will drop the cost of attendance. Individual who qualify for USAW monies will receive a reduction based upon the number of individuals who qualify for said money. ***** All room and board including meals is covered during the camps. Once the athletes arrive in Fargo, they are responsible for the costs of their food. *****

Cost of Camp Attendance for Individuals who are not attending Fargo will be \$150.00 per weekend. This covers room and board and food during the camps. Athletes will do seven sessions per camp.

Fargo Deposits: Deposits must be received by the dates outlined below. If alternative payment arrangements need to be made, please contact USAW Treasurer directly. Payments in full must be received prior to departure for Fargo. Due to the costs and advanced arrangements that must be made, there will be no exceptions to this. **Please make checks out to MT-USAW.**

- If a wrestler is not able to attend or has to cancel, after payment(s) have been made, an amount to cover costs incurred will be withheld from any refund.
- Refunds will be issued at the conclusion of the Team Montana/Fargo trip

QUALIFICATION

Junior Division

Wrestler must have qualified in a competitive event conducted under sanction of USA Wrestling in the state where he/she resides, and must be certified by the state association. For Men's Freestyle and Greco-Roman, each state may enter a maximum of forty-five (45) wrestlers in each style and a maximum of four (4) wrestlers in any one (1) weight class, per style. For Women's Freestyle, there is no limit for the amount of female wrestlers each state can enter in this style. In addition, the top three place winners from USA Wrestling's Junior Division Regional Championships and the FILA Junior National Championships qualify for this event but must still adhere to all individual state association policies.

Cadet Division

Wrestler must have qualified in a competitive event conducted under sanction of USA Wrestling in the state where he/she resides, and must be certified by the state association. Each state may enter a maximum of fifty-one (51) wrestlers in each style and a maximum of four (4) wrestlers in any one (1) weight class, per style. For Women's Freestyle, there is no limit for the amount of female wrestlers each state can enter in this style. In addition, the top three place winners from USA Wrestling's Cadet Division Regional Championships and the FILA Cadet National Championships qualify for this event but must still adhere to all individual state association policies.

Montana Qualifications

Montana athletes qualify for the Fargo team through placing in the top three at the USAW State tournament in Kalispell, MT on April 28-29th, and an additional spot is available via a wrestle off at camp as needed for a total of 4 per weight class. The only other way to make either team is by placing either at the Fila Cadet Nationals, or one of the Cadet and Jr. Regional qualifying tournaments. Athlete who want to be eligible for the money set aside by the USAW board, must wrestle the qualifier (or petition due to being at a national/regional level tournament), the state tournament and one other Montana USAW sanctioned tournament.
