Very Important Info: All COACHES and ATHLETES must go ONLINE and purchase your AAU cards (aausports.org) <u>BEFORE</u> the tournament. You must have your card with you at time of registration.

Registration: It is encouraged to register and pay online at www.trackwrestling.com. Online registration will close FRIDAY March 13, 2015 at 10 a.m. Onsite registration will be available at an additional \$20.00, please register onsite according to wrestler check-in/weigh-in times.

Entry Fee: \$12.00 per wrestler, when registered on www.trackwrestling.com. Onsite registration per wrestler is \$32.00. Copy of birth certificate and current AAU card are required for all wrestlers. **No Club checks will be accepted**.

Wrestler Check-In/ Weigh-Ins/ Registration: Friday, March 13th 2:00 – 4:00 p.m. S.B- Elite. 5:00 – 9:00 p.m. Tot-Novice

No Saturday morning weigh-ins or Registration.

The ½ pound rule will apply for all weigh-ins. This means that if you are ½ pound or less over, you will be allowed to lose this weight and weigh again. If you are over ½ pound above the weight class, you will not be allowed to weigh again. You will be allowed to challenge one other scale. There will not be an additional charge if they do not make weight and the wrestler will automatically be moved to the next weight class.

Wrestlers MUST weigh in with a singlet.

Coaches: Coaches passes will be handed out Friday evening and Saturday morning. Coaches' passes are \$20.00, this gets you on the floor and into the hospitality room. Each coach must have an AAU card and have proof that they have passed the CURRENT PCA coaches class available online at aausports.org. This class is mandatory to coach on the floor at the state tournament, your card must be dated 2015. Each coach must also have taken the MTWOA Rules Clinic given at various locations across the state. There will be a MTWOA Clinic held Friday at 5p.m., the cost is \$10.

ALL COACHES ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE THE FOLLOWING: UPDATED PCA COACHES CARD, AAU MEMBERSHIP CARD, & MTWOA RULES CLINIC CARD.
