#### **ENTRIES**

All entries must be received by **Midnight on Jan. 15** via Track Wrestling. **NO LATE ENTRIES.** Entries will be limited to 150 wrestlers for the morning session and 150 wrestlers for the afternoon session.

#### **ENTRY FEE**

\$7.00 per wrestler collected during registration.

#### **AGE/DIVISIONS**

USAW Age Divisions will be used.

#### **NEW** this year:

PeeWee, Bantam, Intermediate will be grouped in 4 man round robins by weight in a takedown format

Novice, Schoolboy/girl, Cadet will be bracketed using horizontal championship brackets

#### **Novice-Cadet (Folkstyle format)**

#### **RULES**

There will be a short clinic at 8:30 am on the mat for wrestlers and coaches to go over the rules, scoring, and criteria for breaking ties.

#### MORNING:

- Four-man, three-man, and two-man round-robin brackets will be used. We will try to place as many wrestlers as possible into four-man round-robin brackets.
- Takedowns are each worth 1 point.
- After points are awarded, the clock will **not** stop and the wrestlers will be placed back into the neutral position.
- If a wrestler gains a 10 point lead on an opponent at any time during the match, it will result in a technical fall & the match will end.
- · Matches will consist of one 4-minute running clock period
- In the case of a tie there will be a 30 second sudden death period in the neutral position. If tie remains, wrestlers will go to a clinch with the wrestler with the first takedown getting choice in clinch.
- If the wrestler with the advantage in the clinch scores a takedown he/she wins. If not, the other wrestler wins.

#### AFTERNOON:

- USAW Folkstyle Tournament Rules apply.
- 3 1.5 min periods
- · Horizontal Champ brackets

#### **AWARDS**

Medals 1st - 3rd place
Ribbons 4th - 6th place
\*All proceeds go to the home club

#### **ADMISSION**

\$5.00 adults, \$3.00 students and 5 & under free.

#### CONCESSIONS

Limited concessions are available throughout the tournament.

#### **FUNDRAISING OPPORTUNITY!**
